Pastor Verification of Participation For Subsidy

4. Participate in the annual diocesan Catholic Sharing Appeal (C.S.A.)
5. Use of your time and talent to the various ministries and organizations within the parish.

I understand that I, as pastor, am expected to pay from the parish a subsidy of \$800.00 per student for the coming year to the above school by March 1, 2019. I further understand that during the course of the year, I can revoke the subsidy if the family is not following the standards established by the parish. If this happens, I, as pastor, will notify the school and the family would be expected to pay the full tuition rate.

Financial Assistance Parish Participation Grant

The giving of one's time, talent and treasure and abiding by basic Catholic responsibilities are indicators of parish participation. By adhering to these indicators, a family is entitled to the privilege of having a Catholic tuition rate. When a family fails to meet the necessary criteria, the family places itself in a position of losing the privilege of the Catholic School tuition rate.

Please review your commitment to St. John Parish and stop by the "Welcome Desk" after Mass to complete the form with Msgr. Flaherty. If you meet the criteria established by the pastors in Pensacola, your form will be signed by your pastor and returned to St. John School. If you feel that you need to set up an appointment with the pastor, this can be arranged and is encouraged. The St. John Church office can be reached at 850-455-0356.

Note: In order for the Participation Grant Form to be signed a family must be registered, contributing parishioners at St. John the Evangelist for at least four months.

Outside St. John Parish

Those registered in Catholic parishes other than St. John the Evangelist are asked to take the Parish Participation Grant Form to the parish office where they are registered and leave it for their pastor. Your pastor in turn will return it to St. John School. Please thank the pastor of your parish for his financial assistance to St. John School.

Additional Financial Aid

Limited financial assistance to St. John School is available. If you feel that you need some financial assistance, we encourage you to begin immediately to submit application packages. All families requesting assistance must submit a request for financial aid through FACTS Tuition Assistance (a link is available via the school website). Additionally, all families must attempt to obtain funding assistance from outside sources (Step Up For Students, John McKay Scholarship, Gardiner Scholarship, Kremer Foundation Grant, etc.).
