

## **Important:**

Do you have a **fever** or signs of a respiratory infection (cough/sore throat)?

Have you been in **personal contact** with anyone who has been diagnosed with or is presumed to have COVID-19 within the past 14 days?

- ***If you answer yes to any one of these questions, please contact the front office at 850-456-5218 to make other arrangements for drop off.***

## **Procedure**

Please place your carline sign on the dash of your car and proceed through car line normally except we will form one line only.

See the schedule below for specific times; ***note that families with siblings in multiple grades should come at the scheduled time of the oldest child.***

- In addition to the specific grade level times, we are also offering a 3:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. drop off time for anyone who can't make the specific grade level time. Please use your assigned grade level time to the extent possible.
- CDC guidelines will be followed by staff.
- **Materials to be dropped off include school textbooks, borrowed devices and all ipads-plus the charger (12 V white block) and the cord.**

There will be a fee for any unreturned textbooks and devices or if a textbook/device is returned damaged.
